The Smelser/Konopnicki Alumni Scholarship



The Smelser/Konopnicki alumni scholarship has been established to honor the lives of Daniel and Rosa Smelser, and Stanley and Tina Konopnicki. This scholarship will be awarded to an upper class music major that views music as a ministry, seeks to honor God, and further His Kingdom through music.

Qualifications:

- Must be enrolled full-time
- Must be a returning student
- Must be a Music Major
- Must have a current cumulative G.P.A. of 3.00 or better
- Must be in compliance with college financial, spiritual, social and educational policy as stated in the catalog and student handbook

Conditions:

- One scholarship will be awarded each year in the amount of \$500
- Half of the award value will be credited to the student's account at the end of the fall semester and the other half at the end of the spring semester
- Payment of the award is contingent upon completion of the semester
- Applications must be submitted no later than May 1 (references postmarked no later than May 1) and can be submitted to the college Financial Aid Office
- Applications will be reviewed and scholarships awarded by the sponsoring family
- The recipient will be directly notified by the sponsoring family no later than June 1
- Each award will be applied to the upcoming academic year. The funds cannot be used to pay off any existing accounts owed to the College.
- Should the recipient fail to live up to the qualifications stipulated above, between the time they are awarded the scholarship and the end of a semester, the school reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship and the sponsoring family will award it to another qualified applicant
- Should the student awarded the scholarship decide not to return to Urshan College they forfeit claim to the scholarship
