Essential Functions:

- Teach 24 units annually in speech and communication studies courses designed for Communication Studies majors as prescribed in the undergraduate Faculty Handbook.
- Recruit and mentor students within the Communication Studies major, including the maintenance of regular on-campus office hours as prescribed by the Faculty Handbook.
- Participate in the governance of the Communication Studies program.
- Be active in both the local community and the local church in ways that support their academic expertise and endeavors.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Accredited Master's degree in communication studies or a closely related field.
- Teaching experience in a university/college setting preferred.
- Strong classroom presence, having the ability to effectively engage Communication Studies majors.
- Evidence of a strong personal faith and a desire to minister to students as they grow in their faith and in their understanding of personal calling.
- Clear potential for future scholarly work.
