The candidate should be able to teach both introductory and upper-level courses. The Human Services program is committed to preparing Apostolic students for service and further education in the areas of social work, counseling, mental health, and psychology. We are seeking candidates who share a vision of these God-given callings as part of the holistic mission of the Church, are enthusiastic about working in and building up a cutting-edge program, and demonstrate high levels of competence both in classroom instruction and in student mentoring. Because Urshan College is owned and operated by the United Pentecostal Church International, we are seeking candidates who are active ministers and/or members of the UPCI and have a strong commitment to Oneness Pentecostal doctrine and practice.

Essential Functions:

- Teach up to 12 units annually in human services, sociology, psychology, and/or counseling courses designed for Human Services majors in the undergraduate Faculty Handbook.
- Mentor students within the Human Services major, including the maintenance of regular on-campus office hours as prescribed by the Faculty Handbook.
- Participate in **all** faculty in-services, meetings and professional development seminars.
- Participate in committees and additional administrative duties as needed.
- Be active in both the local community and the local church in ways that support their academic expertise and endeavors.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Accredited Master's degree in human services or a closely related field such as counseling, psychology, social work, or pastoral counseling.
- Teaching experience in a university/college setting preferred.
- Strong classroom presence, having the ability to effectively and creatively engage Human Services majors.
- Evidence of a strong personal faith and a desire to minister to students as they grow in their faith and in their understanding of personal calling.
- Clear potential for future scholarly work.

Salary:

Half-time position. Rank and salary are commensurate with education and experience, including benefits.
