Description

Urshan College is pleased to announce an opening for a full-time faculty member in the Music Program to begin Fall 2021. The candidate should be able to teach both introductory and upper-division music courses. The Music program offers two degrees, the Bachelor of Arts in Worship Ministry (BAWM) and the Bachelor of Music (BM). In the BAWM program we are committed to preparing Apostolic students for service in a local church or a para-church organization with excellence in a broad range of worship-related skills, while the BM program prepares students for graduate studies in music or related fields and ultimately be employed in their specialized field of music.

We are seeking candidates who share a vision of these God-given callings as part of the holistic mission of the Church, are enthusiastic about working in and building up a cutting-edge program, and demonstrate high levels of competence in classroom instruction, in student mentoring, and in musical performance. Because Urshan College is owned and operated by the United Pentecostal Church International, we are seeking candidates who are active ministers and/or members of the UPCI and have a strong commitment to Oneness Pentecostal doctrine and practice. The preferred candidate will:

- Teach 24 units annually in private piano instruction, private voice instruction, Chamber Choir, and/or additional music courses as needed.
- Mentor students within the Music Program, including the maintenance of regular on-campus office hours as prescribed by the Faculty Handbook.
- Participate in the governance of the Music Program.
- Be active in both the local community and the local church in ways that support their academic expertise and endeavors.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Accredited Master's degree in Music with emphasis in one or more of the following: piano, voice, choral conducting.
- Teaching experience in a university/college setting preferred.
- Strong classroom presence, having the ability to effectively engage music majors.
- Evidence of a strong personal faith and a desire to minister to students as they grow in their faith and in their understanding of personal calling.
- Clear potential for future performance and scholarly work.

Salary: Full-time position. Rank and salary are commensurate with education and experience, including benefits.
